In fact, the Regulatory Authority for Energy (RAE) has been receiving applications for permits concerning battery storage plants. How many MW is a battery energy storage system? The highest awarded subsidy came at EUR58773/MW/year and refers to a 7.9 MW/31.6 MWh project located in the same region. Greek firm Hellenic Renewables, which is a subsidiary of Helleniq Energy, offered the lowest successful bids for two battery projects of 25 MW/100 MWh each.
