ESS News had previously reported on some of announcements made already by winning developers, including Enlight securing 300 MW of storage rights through its Neot Smadar and Ohad projects, which will initially operate under regulated tariffs before transitioning to the merchant market. How much does a MWh system cost? MWh (Megawatt-hour) is a measure of energy capacity (how long the system can continue delivering that power output). For example, a 1 MW / 4 MWh BESS has four hours of storage capacity. So, while the system might be \$200,000 per MW, the effective cost can be \$800,000 per MWh if it has four hours duration. How much will a battery cost in ? Lower Battery Pack Costs: Battery costs can fall to \$50-60/kWh by , accompanied by the corresponding reduction in BESS capital costs. Market Maturity & Competition: Higher numbers of manufacturers in the market will drive down costs.
