This initiative aims to enhance the flexibility and stability of Portugal's power supply system amid its record-breaking solar electricity production. On July 31, the ministry announced the allocation of EUR99.75 million through a call for tenders to install energy storage projects totaling 500 MW. What is the biggest energy storage grant in Portugal? The biggest grant was awarded to Solara4Phase4 to the tune of EUR 16.4 million. A total of 43 projects were selected from 79 applications in Portugal's energy storage procurement. This included six projects from Spain's Iberdrola, which secured nearly EUR 20 million in public funding. How has solar technology changed the energy industry in Portugal? Particularly in solar, there has been a significant reduction of costs associated with PV technology since 2010, alongside with the high level of predictability of solar resources, has led to an increase of the number of requests for energy production licenses in Portugal.
