What does the / budget mean for Egypt?The / budget signals a strategic approach that balances fiscal responsibility with increased investment in key social and economic sectors, reinforcing Egypt's commitment to long-term stability and sustainable development. What does the new budget mean for EGP?The new budget reflects record spending and a continued commitment to economic growth, social protection, and fiscal stability. Finance Minister Ahmed Kouchouk outlined the budget's key figures, noting that projected revenues will reach EGP 3.1trn, reflecting a 19% annual increase, while expenditures are set at EGP 4.6trn, marking an 18% rise. Why did Egypt's inflation fall in February ?Inflation also showed a notable decline, falling to 12.8% in February from 19.8% in February , largely due to lower global commodity prices.
