How many applications were submitted for market premiums in Serbia?Forty applications were submitted for market premiums within the procedure for the second round of renewable electricity auctions in Serbia, Balkan Green Energy News learns. The call for wind and solar power projects was launched in late November and the deadline for applications expired on February 5. How much money will be spent on infrastructure projects in Serbia?A large portion of the funds are going to infrastructure projects, including road, rail, air, and water upgrades. In August , Serbian President Vucic announced a new investment cycle worth EUR12 billion, aimed at preparing the Serbian capital Belgrade to host the World Expo. How much wind power will Serbia have in ?The ministry laid out the provisional targets for : Add 3.51 GW in wind power or ten times more than what is now installed in Serbia. Read the full news here. How much does electricity cost in Serbia?Serbia changed both the price ceiling and the criterion for evaluating the bids. The maximum acceptable bid for wind farms is EUR 79 per MWh, compared to 105 per MWh last time. The ceiling for electricity from photovoltaic plants is EUR 72 per MWh, while it was EUR 90 per MWh last time. How much more solar power will the government have in ?The government is targeting 100 times more solar power and 10 times more capacity in wind parks for . It aims to cut greenhouse gas emissions by 40.3% and achieve a share of 41% of renewables in gross final energy consumption by the end of the decade.
